Equipment

All athletes must have their own gum shield, groin guard (for males), gauze hand wraps, tape, boxing oil, vaseline, mongkol/prajeet, team uniform/shirt

Professional Muay Thai

Professional Fights of only 2 people in 1 category will be classed as Prestige bouts (no belt), Over 3 people in 1 category (e.g. 4 man tournament) belt will be awarded to the winner.

Dap Thai



Dap Thai or Krabi Krabong uses two swords and full body protection. The aim is to land strikes on your opponent whilst correctly and gracefully performing the traditional techniques and movements.

Entry Requirements

Medical & Insurance

- Participants must bring a medical examination certificate to prove they are fit to take part (not older than 12 months) or they will have to undergo a formal examination in Thailand and will be charged extra.
- All participants must have private insurance

Visa

- Participants are responsible for their own visa. Please speak with your National representative regarding any VISA requirements or apply for a VISA from your own Embassy, Consulate or VISA Office in your country.

Minors

- Competitors under the age of 18 must prove parental/guardian permission to participate.

Fees

Seminar fee (Registration included)

- Muay Boran = \$200 USD
- Krabi Krabong = \$200 USD
- Ring officials course = \$200 USD

Registration fee - *All fees to be paid on registration day*

- All athletes, officials and supporters issued an event ID Card = \$120 USD per person
- An athlete who wishes to fight in more than one division + \$25 per sport (under our organisation (Amateur Muay boran, Pro-am muay thai, professional muay thai, Boxing, Dap Thai, Keta Muay Thai) Kickboxing + \$80usd
- Supporters/spectators \$80usd (Revised price)
- Supporters/spectators under age 14 years - FREE

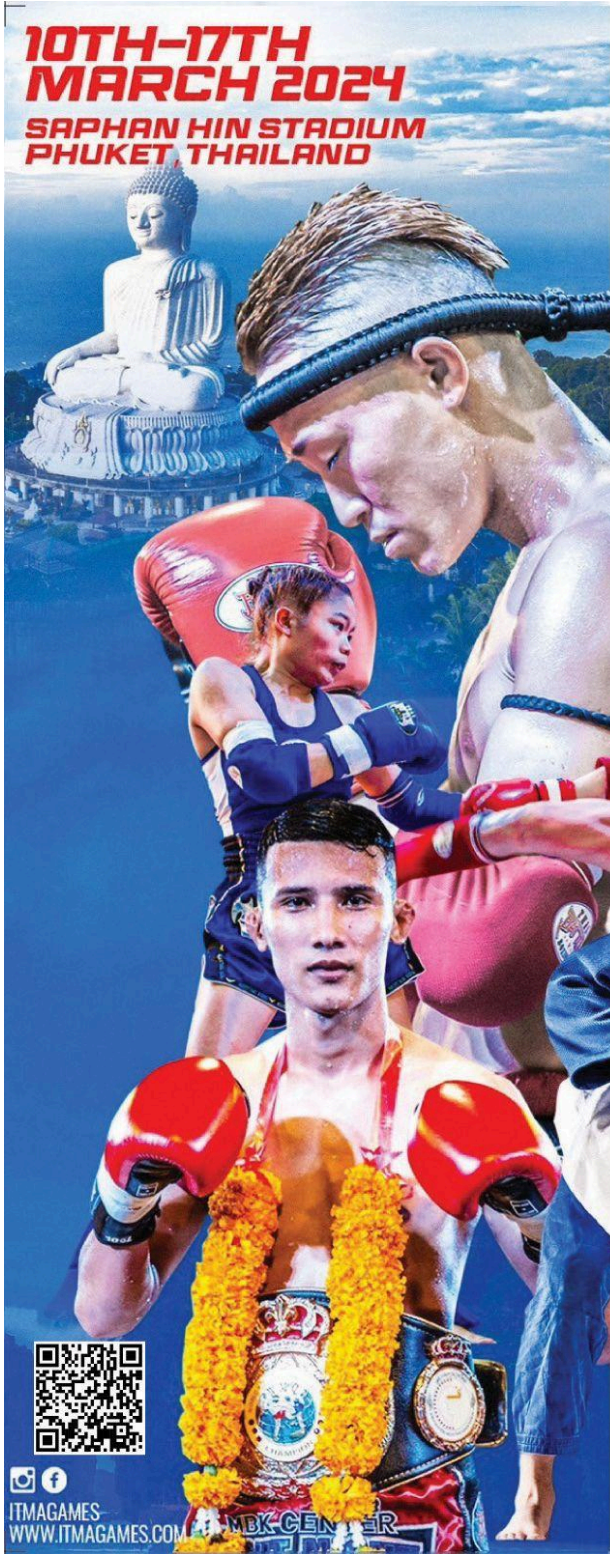
